The Town Council of the Town of Oxford met for a Special Meeting on Thursday August 13, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. Tina Coffman, Terry Zink, Cindy Millburg, and Austin Rennick were present. Town employees and department heads present included Clerk-Treasurer Tina Porter.

Meeting was called to order by Coffman at 6:30 pm – Quorum present

Department Reports:

Porter provided information on the budget estimates, employee benefit options, and possible salary options for 2027. Previous quotes for mosquito spray from the public works department as well as mower maintenance quotes were presented along. The park committee quotes for gutters were again presented and a new quote and request for payment upon receipt for a new body cam for the Marshal's department was presented. A proposal from INDOT was also presented for traffic marking on McConnell.

Old Business:

Rennick made a motion to accept the quote from JA Stock Corp for mosquito spray in the amount of 3223.84 as well as up to \$1,000 to cover larvicide. Millburg seconded. None opposed.

Millburg made a motion to approve the quote for Gutter Flow to complete gutter work on the Old Academy Shelter contingent on completing the requirements of being set up as a new vendor. Zink seconded. None opposed.

New Business:

Rennick made a motion to support INDOT's proposal for traffic marking and no parking locations on McConnell St coming up to the Justus intersection. Millburg seconded. None opposed.

The 2027 AIM Medical renewal decision was tabled.

Millburg made a motion to accept the quote from DRC Mobile for new bodycam and to allow payment upon receipt. Rennick seconded. None opposed.

Rennick made a motion to approve the maintenance quotes for two mowers from Grubb Implement. Zink seconded. None opposed.

Millburg made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Zink seconded. None opposed. Meeting was adjourned at 7:01 p.m.
